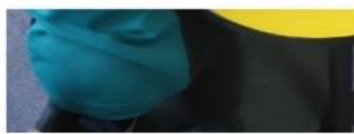
In Yellow, Blue and Red Rooms they are also focusing on addition and developing strategies to solve number problems. Their Writing focus is on 'Organisation'.
