Assembly:

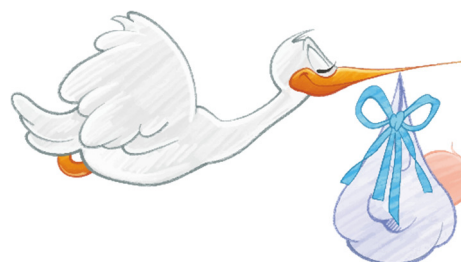

Parent-Teacher Interviews:

The interviews are a time for you to discuss your child's Semester One reports, discuss their progress and their individual learning goals. Bookings will be available through the new Xuno Family App (hopefully), and paper booking forms will also be made available next week.

6+1 Writing Traits:

As previously mentioned, to align with our School Strategic Plan, we are implementing the 6+1 Writing Traits program. This week all grades have been working on the 'Ideas' trait. Students are understanding and identifying that writing inspiration or 'Ideas' are everywhere. Ask your child what they have learnt about the 'Ideas' trait and this will help reinforce their learning.

Here are some student reflections on the 'Ideas' Trait...

You can look around for ideas and then you can look and listen. You can turn these ideas into a sentence. We read about 'animal foods' and then we drew pictures of food and wrote about it. Writing Traits are fun! – Tex, Yellow Room

For this week we have been learning about the "Ideas' trait. We focused our ideas and expanded them with our classmates' help. We read the book, 'The Swing' and connected the ideas in the story to our own lives. – Anonymous, Red Room

This week we have learned about the Trait 'Ideas'. We read a book called '*If Kids Ran the World*' and we wrote down all the ideas that popped into our heads whilst listening to the story. We discussed our ideas and couldn't believe how many came to us in just one book. We then chose one idea each and added detail. We also made 'Idea' anchor charts in pairs and we chose one that stood out the most to be the class anchor chart. – Nicki W, Orange Room
