Thanks to some hard work by Riveena the school has been successful with 2 grant applications. The Junior Landcare and Biodiversity Grant comes with a grand total of \$4,500 and the Strengthening Rural Communities Program grant comes with a total of \$10,000. The first grant will enable the students to experience biodiversity learning through incursions and the 2nd grant will enable some much needed refurbishment work to be undertaken on the community hall. Both projects support our drive to keep making our school a beautiful place to learn, play and make friends.
