Yellow & Blue Rooms completed their printing unit in Term 3 and all students have a wonderful 'Book about Bugs' that show their printing and other bug drawings. At the end of Term 3 students started working on some Papier Mâché shaker constructions – they will finish them this term.

Red, Orange & Purple Rooms also completed their printing unit last term, and all have 'My Op Art' books that show their acetate and foam printing, as well as some op art drawings. Most students also created an extra foam print that is currently on display in the Art Room. Students started a Constellation Construction unit inspired by First Nations Artist, Gail Mabo. They will also complete them this term.

Term 4

This term students will have the opportunity to create a ceramic piece. Yellow & Blue Room students will create a Ceramic Face and Red, Orange & Purple students will create either a Coil Plate or Coil Pot. All pieces will be fired in a kiln and students will be able to bring them home at the end of the year with their folios.
