Principal's Report

Haunted Hall

Nikki Willett and her team from the Bruthen and District Community House have done an amazing job putting together a great night of fun and entertainment for the kids and parents. We are very grateful that proceeds from the night will go towards our school. Many of our staff will be on deck to help with the stalls and games, so we look forward to seeing you there. Drumbeat Program Begins

We are very excited to launch the Drumbeat Program at school this term, with Megan leading the way implementing this opportunity for our kids. Our Drumbeat program is designed for small groups of about 6 students to learn some Djembe drumming techniques. This is to help connections between students from different age groups across the school. Students will learn to work together, build resilience, develop listening skills, develop an understanding of difference, role model positive social behaviours and learn respect. Students will participate in the program 2 afternoons a week for 4 weeks, with a new group of students starting another cycle.

School Camps

For many of our students they will be participating in a camping program over the next couple of weeks. The 3/4s will kick it off when they return from the Melbourne Cup Weekend and this camp will also see the Yr 2 students join the campers for a day of outdoor activities on Friday 1st November. Our Year 5 and 6 students are off to Melbourne Camp on November 12th for an action packed 4 days of sight seeing and activities. Administering of Medication

We have observed in recent times more students requesting Panadol, Nurofen or Claratyne to be administered during school hours. This can only happen with the consent of a parent or guardian. Fortunately, the school has a supply of these onboard to support students and families but in more recent times we have been administering these at a higher rate. If your child needs the support of medicine please send it with your child to school in an envelope with a letter explaining how much they need, when they need to have it and have your child give it to the teacher upon arrival at school. Our stock of the medicines outlined above are in limited supply and will be kept in our first aid bags to be used for excursions and camps.

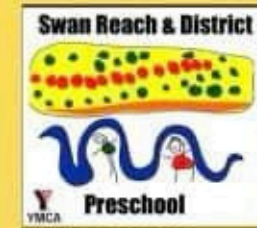
