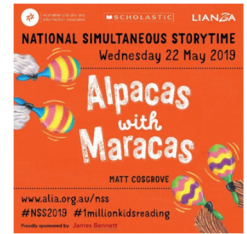
Acting Principal’s Message...

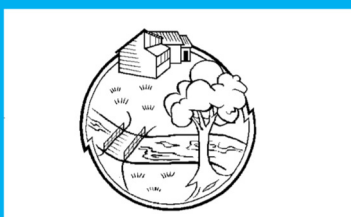
