Tambo Upper Primary School makes every effort to keep the cost of items and activities to a minimum and affordable for all families.

Essential Educational items will be purchased through the school in a bulk order which will save on costs. They will then be assigned to the classes where the teacher will be responsible for distributing the materials to the students. This will enable the teacher to better manage the supplies and prevent loss of material, and also ensure consistency of class materials within the class.

Financial Support for Families

Tambo Upper Primary School understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers a range of support options, including:
